The America's Most Responsible Companies 2026 ranking focuses on a holistic view of corporate responsibility, evaluating the top 2,000 public companies headquartered in the U.S. across 30 key performance indicators as well as an independent survey of 18,000 U.S. residents. The ranking represents the 600 companies with the highest overall corporate social responsibility scores across 14 industries. Since the annual ranking was introduced in 2019, Eversource has appeared in every edition of the list.

Eversource's commitment to sustainability has resulted in landmark clean energy accomplishments, including its first-in-the-nation networked geothermal pilot project in Framingham, Massachusetts, award-winning Outer Cape Battery Energy Storage System in Provincetown, Massachusetts, and first commercial-scale offshore wind project with South Fork Wind off Long Island, New York. As part of its efforts to advance renewable energy across its three-state service territory, the energy company is also dedicated to supporting the development of large, utility-scale solar projects and facilities, as well as providing incentives for customers to install their own solar projects at home. Eversource has also received numerous independent national recognitions for its industry-leading sustainability efforts, such as its ranking as the #1 energy efficiency provider in the country, according to the most recent American Council for an Energy Efficient Economy (ACEEE) Utility Energy Efficiency Scorecard.
